



ATHRA STATE ENVIRONMENT AND ACCESS COORDINATOR POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position reports directly to the National Accreditation Environment & Access Coordinator and forms the ATHRA National Environment & Access group that supports ATHRA's aims and objectives within the confines of this topic.

Each State position will be supported by the relative ATHRA State Executive and the National team.

Each State Environment & Access Coordinator will address all environmental and access issues of immediate and potential future concern to ATHRA by:

- Actively encourage club involvement in the resolution of environmental and access issues
- Being aware of management plan review calendars of relevant public land managers
- Notifying clubs directly affected by management plan reviews
- Notifying clubs directly affected by any other environmental and access issues
- Assisting clubs, where appropriate, formulate their own submissions to issues papers/draft management plans – what do they want!
- Formulate ATHRA submission (precedent) to issues papers/draft management plans inclusive of:
 - support for the relevant club submission
 - all relevant elements from the 'ATHRA ENVIRONMENTAL AND ACCESS GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS'
- Establish a working relationship with all relevant public land managers
- Develop alliances with other like minded entities to optimise the latter
- Supervise maintenance of their States Tracks and Access web page
- Form and support the network team comprising of the other State position holders
