Description:

Handler is to demonstrate the correct way of securing a horse.

Objectives:

The handler is to demonstrate the correct knot, height & length (of rope) of securing a horse.

Choice of Gait:

Standstill

Effectiveness:

Horse remains calm and unconcerned with the challenge

Horse to remain secured for a period of 30 seconds.

The rope distance is to be a minimum of 1 metre in height and .5 metre length. The knot used is to be of the quick release type.

Penalties:

Horse pulls back - Re-Sit
Handler secures rope to low – Penalty
Handler secures horse too long – Penalty
Handler doesn't use quick release knot - penalty
Horse refuses to be tied up - Re-Sit
