## **Description:**

A horse and rider combination whilst cantering to lead a horse also at a canter for a minimum distance of 25 metres.

# **Objectives:**

Rider to have control of both horses and showing no signs of rushing or bolting. Both horses to display signs of comfort during exercise.

### **Choice of Gait:**

Canter

#### **Effectiveness:**

The horse and rider combination whilst cantering and leading a horse are to have control over both equines with limited length of lead rope and correct position of lead horse. (Lead rope ideally to be no longer than 1 metre from hand to clip and lead horses head to be at riders knee.)

### **Penalties:**

Unable to maintain ridden horse gait –penalty
Unable to maintain lead horse gait –penalty
Rider falls off- Re-Sit
Lead horse too far in front or behind rider – penalty
Length of lead rope – penalty
Lead or ridden horse kicks out – Re-Sit
