Description:

Ride a horse up to a rope where a tin can (which has stones within it) is attached to the object (tree or post) untie the rope and drag the can either forward or in reverse for 3 metres. Rope length to be around the 3-4 metres in length.

Objectives:

Horse to remain calm and in control and not display any significant signs of concern.

Choice of Gait:

Walk or trot

Effectiveness:

Ridden horse to show no signs of concern or display signs of "running away", whilst tin can is dragged.

Penalties:

Horse panics and runs away -penalty Horse is uncontrollable –Re-Sit Ride falls off – Re-Sit Rider drops rope-penalty
