Description:

Ride a horse through a bog that has an absorption of 15cm for a distance of 2 metres minimum.

Objectives:

To ride a horse calmly through a bog, horse is to remain calm and in control.

Choice of Gait:

Walk

Effectiveness:

The ridden horse is to calmly walk through the bog with little indication of concern and follow the forward cue of the rider.

Penalties:

Horse refuses forward cue .-Penalty Horse leaps into bog - Penalty Horse rears or spins backwards. - Re-Sit Horse rushes - Penalty
