Directions:

55ks west of Guyra on the Guyra/Tingha Rd.

From Armidale head up to Guyra & turn left at the big sheep towards Inverell.

Travel about 55ks, the property is on a straight part of the road.

It is 4ks past the Old Armidale Rd.

When you see the green sign I35 (Inverell 35ks) you will see a property called Chrystal Hill, we are the next property about 200metres on the left, it is a straight part of the road and there are about 6 white guide posts between the properties, just after the orange guide post is the driveway. I will try to remember to put some balloons or something out.

Go through the gate and veer right on the track then when you get close to the house go left on the track and through the trees. There are yards and shady trees behind the house.

Ride Details:

Ground is soft in some areas but there are rocks (not gravel) around. We do not have to cross any creeks. There are some wet patches but horses that don't like getting their feet wet can cross on the track. The property is undulating, it should be fairly easy and we will most likely stay on tracks that we can drive on.

My horse is not shod but some may want to put boots on, the ground is probably softer than most of the rides that I have been on this year (except if we cross rocks)

BBQ lunch at the end of the ride or we can break and have a BBQ lunch. Please bring meat or alternative for yourself and salad or desert to share, there is a fridge to put anything in that you want to keep cold.

Pre-nomination is required for all NETRA rides so the ride co-ordinator knows how many are attending the ride and if the necessary ATHRA Accredited Trail Bosses are available. Rides may be cancelled if there are insufficient pre-nominations.

Please Note that helmets are compulsory on all NETRA rides.






December Ride Report

Please note that if you wish to ride in the Forest you can access it through some narrow "garden" gates at various locations. Probably the easiest and safest is off Pine Forest Rd. It is a quiet place for loading and unloading your horse. It is also possible to borrow a key from the Council for a few days and that will give you access through any of the gates. Keep off single lane tracks if it is wet and be aware you will probably encounter dogs and mountain bikes.
