

## **Ride Information**

Start Time:	9:00am for a 9:30am departure
Directions: Ride Description:	If you are coming from Canberra - Micalago Rd is on the east side of the Monaro Highway 1km south of the Michelago Service station. Once on Micalago Road travel approximately 5.7km (7 minutes) until you get to a cattle grid with a white timber gate on the left. Ilmmediately after the cattle grid turn left into the paddock where you will see a Tinderry Trail Horse Riders sign. Please park cars/floats trucks in this area along the fence. 4 to 5 hour ride over approximately 16kms of undulating paddocks and
Ride Difficulty:	woodland. Easy but traveling at a fast walking pace.
Ride Warnings/Alerts:	There may be a small creek crossing and the odd gully to cross. Cattle, sheep and Kangaroos can be found in the paddocks and possibly pigs or deer.
Grid/Map/GPS reference:	See above for directions
Estimated Duration:	4 to 5 hours including stops for morning tea and lunch
First Aid:	A basic first aid kit will be carried on the ride
Emergency Contact:	Mobile phone coverage available during this ride
Horse Fitness:	Moderate – ride is approx. 16kms at a fast-walking pace. Horses must be under your control at all times during the ride.
Catering:	BYO morning tea, lunch and drinking water in saddle bags
Equipment:	Bring headstalls and lead ropes for tying or leading horses
Horse feed:	BYO feed if required
Water Availability:	Dams and creeks are available throughout the ride. No water available at the float parking area.
Horse Shoes:	It is recommended that horses are shod. Unshod horses must be sufficiently conditioned to cope with the ride terrain and the duration. If your horse is unshod we recommend that you carry hoof-boots.
