

Where: to get to Ramp Rd, turn off Pembrooke Rd into Reids Rd. After going over bridge its 1km to a large parking area on right.

Just a safety point when turning into Ramp Rd off Reids Rd it is a big open area but a bit blind to oncoming traffic so the further up you can leave your right turn the better you can see oncoming traffic.

What to expect: The ride is undulating and mostly soft, about a 2hr ride.

Ride will be $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Mostly soft and flat, some stony surfaces ok for horses who are usually unshed. Pace to suit riders on the day, but should be space for those who would like a trot and canter.



Directions: From Wauchope going north along Pembrooke Road. After going under railway at Stoney Creek intersection it is 5 kms. Turn right into Extension Road (no sign). From Pacific Highway take Telegraph Point exit travel NORTH along the old Pacific Hwy until you see a service station on your left. Turn left at the service station into Pembrooke Road 4 kms, (after Reids Road) turn left into Extension Road.

ATHRA MEMBERSHIP EXCITING NEWS FOR KICK STARTING 2021

For all members who have joined our club HTRC by 30 September 2020, memberships

will automatically rollover until 31 December 2021.

This means your membership will now expire on 31 December 2021.

You do not need to do anything for the your membership to roll over, however it would be appreciated if you could log on to your ATHRA login and check your address and email is correct so that when ATHRA sends your new electronic card it goes to the correct address. If you are **unable to do this, please check with the Secretary.**

FOR NEW MEMBERS

CURRENT ATHRA MEMBERSHIP FEES

Adult – riding member 18 years to 79 years - \$100

Junior - riding member 5 years of age to 17 years of age -\$40

Child – riding members under 5 years of age - \$20

Senior – riding member 80 years of age and over - \$60

Social – non riding member - \$30

Family Membership

A "family" is one adult riding member who is the parent or legal guardian and one riding child junior when registered or renewed at the same time. The cost is \$100. The Junior child is free.

Join on line using the 'Family Membership' tab and two on line email confirmations will be sent out to you.

New Members

The same as above but use the "New Member" tab. This will create a new ATHRA membership number. Pay the schedule fee and confirmation will be sent to you.

Day Membership

Limited to two (2) visits per calendar year, that is from 1st January to 31st December. There is a Day Membership page on the ATHRA website but in summary:Two (2) visits per calendar year at \$20 a visit. The cost of one Day Membership registration can be credited towards a full ATHRA membership if paid for HASTINGS TRAIL RIDING CLUB NEWSLETTER FEBRUARY 2021

within seven (7) days of the date of your Day Membership. If the ride you have registered for is postponed for any reason by the Club you have registered to ride with, you will be required to have the date of the ride revalidated by ATHRA. That is, you must notify ATHRA within seven (7) days so that the Day Membership can be transferred as long as it is in the calendar year. HTRC must also notify ATHRA within seven (7) days. There is <u>no</u> payment required to HTRC.

HTRC Membership Fee

All adult members (Juniors are free) that have automatically been renewed by ATHRA for 2021, those who are renewing or new members need to make a Direct Deposit of \$10 into the Hastings Trail Riding Club bank account at Regional Australia Bank BSB 932000 Account No 132063 and send the Treasurer Sarah Glover a copy of your transfer receipt to <u>sarahcando@hotmail.com</u>
