onto Western Boundary Rd, about 2.5 kms from the Tuross turnoff. Follow Western Boundary Rd 4.2 kms and turn right at Triangle Rd.

Follow triangle Rd another 2.6 kms to the Old Mill Rd turn off but stay left (do not go straight ahead onto Old Mill Rd). Continue about another 300 metres and turn right where you see the disused galvinised tank lying on its side on the

right. Follow the vehicle track that goes up a slight rise through an old gateway and park in the cleared area.
