<u> Maulbrooks Road – 15th August</u>



We initially headed in a westerly direction (??) along a fire trail, then bike tracks until we had looped around and found ourselves back on Maulbrooks Rd. We headed north for awhile until we crossed to the eastern side of the road, and down a track that looked like it had been used by logging trucks. For those of you interested in the clinics run through Horse & Hound Services, here is a little info...

The content of the clinics are teaching people how to divide the horse into four separate sections so we can improve all our flat dry work, and pending on the individual can work on head sets, hard stop and turn around in a soft supple and very direct method which will improve the horse and rider to carry on with any discipline in the equine industry. There is no set program, we like to speak to the clients at the start of the weekend, see what they wish to get out of it and what they need help in achieving, then design the weekend to suit the group we have. Shane and I spend 3 - 4 weeks in the Bush or the Mountains every year Trail Riding and also live and work on a 20000 acre sheep and cattle property which Shane spends a lot of the year sitting on his horses mustering and we understand how important a nice relaxed, loose reigned, stress free ride is.
