There is a large sign saying turn left in about 100m for Nangar National Park. It is about 80km from Orange. Follow the dirt road over cattle grids until you see a large burgundy float.

Nangar is 80 km from Orange and the riding can be steep, the camping area is flat/undulating.

As usual if you are camping you need to BYO food, horse yards and camping gear.
